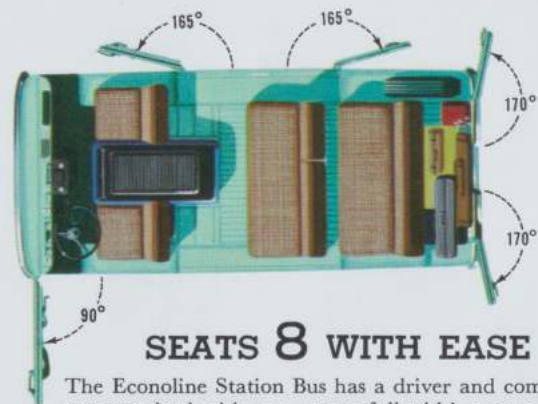


Smart, new vehicle for "station wagon" comfort plus new economy and utility

The Econoline Station Bus has a driver and companion seat standard with one or two full-width seats available in passenger compartment. Large 49.1-inch-wide double door opening at side, with optional retractable step, provides convenient entry to passenger area. Big rear doors give easy access to luggage space: 93.4 cu. ft. with second seat; 32.4 cu. ft. with both rear seats. Front door window rolls down and side windows open front and rear, providing excellent ventilation for added comfort.

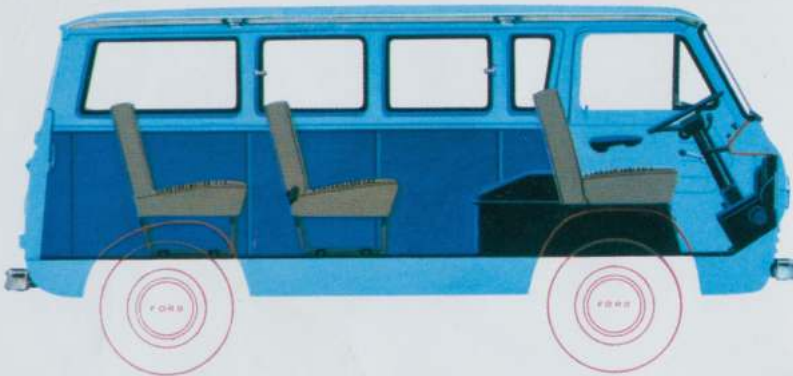
